





- The test could be much more than the scenario










A Manual Approach

- How do we update this data?






Time is Problematic

- You are not alone!













Phased Testing Requirements



- No dedicated test scenarios








Event Based Mutations






Event-Based Mutations


- Reacting to external events

 - Upgrades
 - Migrations
 - Un-Planned
 - Network problems
 - System Crashes
 - Restarts
 - Data surges

- Interruptive
- Non-Interruptive

- Stop everything you're doing
- Migrations
- Some upgrades




Interruptive Events: Challenges


• Carry on your scenarios after the interruptions



Shuffling: Execute with all possible Interruptions








Non-Interruptive Events

- Often Unexpected
- Chaos Testing
- But not always chaotic






Non-Interruptive Events: Challenges


- Wrapping event around the step
- Wrapping the scenario around the event




Non-Interruptive Events: Shuffling








Order Mutations






Order Breaking Mutations: Permutations

- Logical order(s)







Order Breaking Mutations: Permutations




Order Breaking Mutations: Dependency Map










Conclusions - Takeaways


- A scenario can and should be used in many contexts

Conclusions - Evolution


- Bye bye Phased Tests Hello Mutational
